### **RESOLUTION NO. 05-19**

# A RESOLUTION TO REMOVE MINIMUM MAINTENANCE DESIGNATION FROM MEYER LAKE ROAD

Meyer Lake Road is a public road; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Minn. Stat. 160.095 and an information memo from the League of Minnesota Cities dated June 4, 2018 stating that Cities have no clear authority to designate streets as minimum maintenance roads.
